

POOL RULES

Pool rules are provided for the safety and enjoyment of all members and guests. The Inman Park Pool Board thanks all members and guests to the pool for abiding by the rules.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Daily from **6:00am** to **9:00pm** from May 1sthrough September 30sh. Members are not permitted to remain on the pool deck or facilities after 9:00pm.

LIFEGUARDS

The lifeguard schedule is as follows:

May 1st – May 30th	Monday - Friday	03:00pm - 09:00pm
	Saturday - Sunday	11:00am – 09:00pm
Jun 1st – Aug 6th	Monday - Sunday	11:00am – 09:00pm
Aug 7th – Sep 4th	Monday - Friday	03:00pm - 09:00pm

- Problems should be brought to the attention of the attending lifeguard and/or pool manager.
- Obey the lifeguards. They are authorized to enforce the pool rules by expelling members and guests from the pool.
- Do not distract or interfere with lifeguards while they are on duty. Doing so may constitute grounds for expulsion from the pool property.
- Lifeguards have a fifteen (15) minute break every hour. Children under the age of eighteen (18) and non-swimmers are not permitted in the pool during this time.

GENERAL RULES

- Shower and rinse thoroughly before entering the pool.
- Members and guests must always obey the lifeguards.
- Members and guests must treat IPPA property and equipment, and property of other members and guests with respect.
- Glass, sharp objects, or hazardous materials are strictly prohibited.
- Bathers with open wounds, communicable skin conditions should avoid the pool.
- No animals other than service animals are allowed.
- Profanity, intoxication, bullying and other forms of improper behavior are prohibited.
- No running or rowdy behavior is permitted.
- Persons utilizing personal audio devices must use headsets.
- No bicycles, tricycles, or wheeled toys are allowed in the pool area, they should be kept in the bike rack. Strollers should be kept in the upper deck area.
- No balls except soft Nerf type or beach balls are permitted.
- The wading pool is for small children under the age of ten (10).

- Children under the age of sixteen (16) and non-swimmers may not enter the pool area unless accompanied by an adult. Children must always be supervised by an adult when using the pool and pool amenities.
- Pool staff are authorized to restrict or ban the use of flotation devices and toys.

SWIM DIAPERS

- Non-swimming diapers are prohibited in the pools and pool areas. This is required by city health codes and will be strictly enforced.
- Babies and young children who are not toilet trained MUST wear two (2) layers of diapers; one disposable swim diaper and one tight waterproof protective plastic swim pant. Given 'accidents' could require draining and/or otherwise rectify the pool for the health & safety of all members, any members who don't adhere to this policy will be subject to a fine in accordance with the remedy. Repeated offenses could result in revocation of pool membership.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

- Glass containers are prohibited anywhere on the pool property. There is a \$50 fine for bringing in a glass container to the pool.
- No food allowed within five feet of the pool.
- The pool deck and picnic area must remain clean; please clean up after yourself.

GUEST POLICY

- Memberships and membership keys are for the use of the members and their family onlymembers who share their pool key with non-members may be subject to revocation of membership or other fines.
- Each membership may bring a maximum of four (4) guests while visiting the pool. Members must accompany their guest(s). Inviting more than four (4) guests constitutes a party and must be managed through the Party Policy and Procedures. Members not abiding to this rule may be subject to revocation of membership or other fines.
- Guest policies will be enforced with periodic checks by door attendants, lifeguards, volunteers, and/or IPPA board members. Members and their guests should be prepared to verify their membership and have identification to comply with this policy.

CLUBHOUSE

- The clubhouse may be used by members. Children must be accompanied by adults.
- The clubhouse may be booked for events, provided that such usage is requested and approved by the pool management. See the pool website for details.

PARKING

- Parking near the pool is limited. Please carpool, walk or bike whenever possible.
- Parking spaces at the pool entrance are for handicapped persons and emergency access only.
 You may load and unload at the pool entrance, before parking, but do not park in the spaces next to the pool. Do not leave children unattended at drop off.
- When parking on neighborhood streets near the pool, please be respectful of residents and stay clear of driveways.
